REINSTATEMENT ORDER

In the Matter of Munier Fayez Joudeh CPA Certificate No. 09569

The Minnesota Board of Accountancy has determined as follows:

1. The Board is authorized to license and regulate certified public accountants pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 326A.01-.14 (2020).

2. The Board issued Respondent Munier Joudeh a certified public accountant license on April 17, 1986.

3. Munier Joudeh's certified public accountant certificate expired on December 31, 1988.

4. On October 16, 1998, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 326A.04, subd. 11, the Board revoked Munier Joudeh's certificate because he failed to renew it for more than two years after its expiration.

5. On November 22, 2022, Munier Joudeh petitioned to reinstate his revoked certificate pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 326A.09.

6. This order is in the public interest.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 326A.04, .09, that Munier Joudeh's certified public accountant certificate shall be reinstated upon submission of satisfactory proof to the Board that he has completed 120 hours of continuing professional education and payment of \$1,800 in fees, consisting of a \$1,700 delinquency fee, and a \$100 renewal fee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Munier Joudeh does not submit satisfactory proof of completing the continuing-education hours and pay all required fees within 90 days, this order shall be automatically vacated, and Munier Joudeh's certificate shall not be reinstated. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing herein shall be deemed to rescind the Board's order revoking Munier Joudeh's certified public accountant certificate and, moreover, that revocation order and this reinstatement order shall be classified as public data pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13.41, subd. 5 (2022).
