ORDER LIFTING LICENSE SUSPENSION

On April 30, 2012, the Board of Accountancy ("Board") received a letter of License Revocation/Suspension from the Minnesota Department of Revenue ("Revenue"), which advised the Board that Respondent Steven Schlieff ("Respondent") had an overdue tax liability. Under Minnesota Statute § 270C.72 (2022), the Board must suspend Respondent's certificate as a Certified Public Accountant ("CPA"). On May 3, 2012, the Board suspended the CPA license of Respondent. On February 12, 2024, the Board received a License Clearance Certificate from Revenue, indicating that the Respondent does not owe the State any uncontested delinquent taxes, penalties, or interest and has filed all required returns.

In compliance with the Order for Suspension of CPA Certificate issued on May 3, 2012, if a Tax Clearance Certificate is received, the Board shall then issue an Order to rescind the suspension of Respondent's CPA certificate.

ORDER

It is hereby ordered, pursuant to the Minn. Stat. § 270C.72, subd. 1(c) (2022), that the suspension of Steven Schleif's CPA license is rescinded.
