- F) Center for Public Trust (CPT) Ethics Course and Future Visit At the January 11, 2018, Board meeting Alfonzo Alexander, President of CPT will present on student chapter development in Minnesota and on a customizable ethics course developed by CPT that could be used by state Boards as part of remediation in disciplinary cases.
